CAPT Metcalf graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1994 with a Bachelor of Science in Naval Architecture and holds a master's degree from the Naval Post Graduate School in Monterey, California in Mechanical Engineering

CAPT Metcalf's afloat assignments include USS SAN JACINTO (CG 56) as First Lieutenant and Anti-Submarine Warfare Officer, and USS BRISCOE (DD 977) as Main Propulsion Assistant. He also completed two deployments to the Persian Gulf, earning qualifications as a Gas Turbine Engineering Officer and

as a Surface Warfare Officer.

CAPT Metcalf's ashore assignments include Assistant Project Manager for the CVN Refueling and Complex Overhaul program, Damage Control inspector and Trials Coordinator at the Board of Inspection and Survey, Assistant Program Manager in the CVN 21 Program Office (PMS 378) as the Technology Insertion Manager, Principal APM for Requirements, Fleet Introduction, and Test & Trials for the LPD 17 Program Office (PMS 317), Program Manager's Representative for the DDG 1000 Program, Deputy Shipbuilding Director for DDG 1000, and as the Chief of Staff for the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy.

In August 2016, he assumed command as Program Manager for the LPD 17 Program Office (PMS 317) and was selected in January 2020 to serve as Executive Assistant to Commander, Naval Sea Systems Command. In July 2020, CAPT Metcalf was hand-selected to serve as the next Program Manager for the CVN 78 Program (PMS 378).

Captain Metcalf's awards include the Legion of Merit (two awards), Bronze Star, Meritorious Service Medal (four awards), Navy Commendation Medal (two awards), Navy Achievement Medal (three awards), and various unit and campaign awards.
